

PRIVACY POLICY

Welcome to RocketPlay (together with all content on the site and other websites (the "**Services**")) operated by RocketPlay Limited or its subsidiaries or affiliates ("**RocketPlay**" or "**we**").

Your privacy is important to us. To better protect your privacy, we provide this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") explaining our policies and practices regarding the collection, use and disclosure of information we receive and collect on the Services and the choices you can make about the way you share your personal information with us.

1. INTRODUCTION

We are committed to respecting your online privacy and recognize your need for appropriate protection and management of any Personal Information (as defined hereafter) you share with us.

"**Personal Information**" means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, pen name, personal profile, a home or other physical address, credit card details and an email address or other contact information.

In order to access and use the Services, you may be required to register and create an account with RocketPlay (the "Account") or you may need to have a valid account on a social networking service (such as facebook) through which you access the Service (the "SNS" and the "SNS Account", respectively).

If you are required to create an Account, you will be asked to provide us with your name, email address, a username, a password that you will use to access your Account or the Services, and other specified information.

If you are provided with a username and password, it is your responsibility to remember and maintain the security and confidentiality of your username and password. You should not disclose your username and password to any other person.

By voluntarily providing us with your Personal Information, e.g. in the framework of the registration process, or by sending us a comment, a request or a question, you are giving your consent to the collection, use and, as the case may be, distribution of your Personal Information by us, under the terms and for the purposes specified in this Privacy Policy and subject to applicable law.

2. THE WAY WE USE PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may use your Personal Information for several purposes: (1) to enable you to use the Services or certain features thereof; (2) to contact you and to respond to questions and comments you may send us; (3) to save you from re-entering the information when you access the Services; (4) to provide you with marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you (as further detailed below); (5) to

detect and protect against error, fraud or other criminal activity; (6) to enforce our Terms of Use including carrying out security reviews to validate your identity, age, contact details and, if applicable, your financial information; and (7) in any other way as described to you at the time of collection of your Personal Information.

In addition, we may combine your Personal Information and aggregate it with information collected from other users of the Services, in order to better design the Services and its services, by analysing and evaluating the way the Services are being used. We may disclose such aggregated information as provided below.

Subject to applicable law, we may transfer your Personal Information within the group of companies to which RocketPlay belongs or to RocketPlay's third-party service providers, across borders, and from your country or jurisdiction to other countries or jurisdictions within the European Economic Area ("EEA") and outside of the EEA provided that the destination country ensures an adequate level of protection. We shall use reasonable efforts to limit the use of such information and to ensure that appropriate confidentiality and security measures are in place.

Subject to applicable law, we may share and provide Personal Information and non-personally-identifiable information to our subsidiaries, affiliated companies, or other businesses or persons for the purpose of processing such information on our behalf. We shall require that these persons agree to process such information in compliance with our Privacy Policy, and we shall use reasonable efforts to limit their use of such information and ensure that they use appropriate confidentiality and security measures.

We may also employ third party service providers to perform some of the services related to the Services (such as hosting and maintenance services, payments clearance services etc.). Such third parties will have limited access to your Personal Information to the extent necessary to perform their tasks, and are obligated not to disclose or use it for any other purpose. We may also use your email address to send you updates, newsletters or news regarding our services or those of our partners whose offers may interest you. In certain cases, Account holders who register to participate in certain game offered in the framework of the Services will receive update emails and notifications during the course of such game. It may not be possible to block such emails and notifications and by registering for such a game you consent to the receipt of such emails and notifications.

3. AGGREGATED INFORMATION

Anonymous information about visits to the Services - When you access the Services, information about your visit (such as how you navigate the Services) may be collected and stored. This information may include your internet protocol ("IP") address, browser and platform type, the length of your visit, the date and time of your visit, the pages you viewed and the order of those pages, the amount of time spent on particular pages, and the websites you visit before and after visiting the Services website. It does not include any personally identifiable information such as your name, e-mail address or telephone number.

We use this information mainly to monitor and analyse the aggregate use of the Services, and for the Services' technical administration. As mentioned above, we may aggregate such data (alone or with Personal Information) in order to better design the Services.

Subject to the provisions of any applicable law, we may disclose and share such aggregated information (from which your Personal Information cannot be isolated) with interested third-parties. We may also provide advertisers with aggregate information and/or non-identifying information about the Services and its users.

4. COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

Some of our Services pages utilise "cookies" and other tracking technologies to collect information and to tailor the Services to the needs and interests of our customers. A "cookie" is a small text file that is transferred from the Services' servers to your computer's hard drive, and uniquely identifies your browser. Cookies can only be read by the server that sent them to you, and they cannot read data from your hard drive.

Tracking technologies (including cookies) may record information such as internet domain and host names; IP addresses; browser software and operating system types; clickstream patterns; and dates and times that our Services are accessed. Our use of cookies and other tracking technologies allows us to improve our Services and your use thereof.

We use cookies and other tracking technologies to: (1) remember some information (e.g. user name and login password) so that you will not have to re-enter it during each visit to the Services; (2) monitor the effectiveness of marketing campaigns; and (3) monitor aggregate metrics such as total number of visitors, pages viewed, etc.

Please note that you may set most browsers to either notify you when you receive a cookie or to block cookies. However, please note that if you choose to erase or block your cookies, you will need to re-enter certain identifying information, should such information be required at a later time, to gain access to certain parts of the Services.

You should be aware that the Services use the services of third party suppliers for the provision of some of its services. To provide such services, these suppliers may also use cookies, for the reasons outlined above.

5. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT

We may disclose any and all information, including Personal Information, if we are required to do so by any applicable law or regulation, or an order of a court or other governmental body having jurisdiction.

We may also disclose your Personal Information if we, in our good-faith discretion, believe that such disclosure is necessary to: (i) enforce the Terms of Use; (ii) take precautions against possible liability; (iii) investigate and defend ourselves against any (yours or any third party's) claims or allegations; (iv) protect our

property and rights (including the security or integrity of the Services); (v) protect the property, rights or safety of any third party; and/or (vi) prevent or stop any illegal or unethical activity.

6. CHOICE

You may choose whether or not to provide Personal Information to RocketPlay. We will provide notices informing you where RocketPlay collects Personal Information in the framework of the Services, in order to help you to make this choice. If you choose not to provide the Personal Information we request, you may still be able to access most of the Services, but you may be unable to access certain options, offers, and services that involve our interaction with you.

7. ACCESS/ACCURACY

To the extent that you do provide us with Personal Information, you will have access to this Personal Information and you will be able to add information, and delete or correct this Personal Information. You may also, by written request, ask for a copy of the Personal Information that we keep about you (for the provision of such a copy we may, at our sole discretion, charge a small fee) or the rectification of such Personal Information.

8. COLLECTION OF INFORMATION BY THIRD-PARTIES

Our Services may use the services of third parties to present or manage advertisements that you may see in the framework of the Services. These third party ad servers may use cookies, web beacons, clear gifs or similar technologies to help present such advertisements, and to help measure and research the advertisements' effectiveness. The use of such technologies by these third party ad servers is subject to their own privacy policies and is not covered by this Privacy Policy.

9. LINKS TO OTHER WEBSITES

Our Services may contain links to other websites or advertisements of third parties. Other websites may also reference or link to our Services. The fact that such links and advertisements are posted and presented on the Services is not an endorsement of, or representation of any kind in respect of those websites or their privacy policies and practices. We are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such other websites, and encourage you to review the privacy policies of those linked websites before using them.

10. EVENT OF MERGER, SALE, OR BANKRUPTCY

In the event that RocketPlay is acquired by or merged with a third party entity, we reserve the right, subject to applicable law, to transfer or assign the Personal Information we have collected from our users as part of such merger, acquisition, sale, or other change of control.

In the event of our bankruptcy, insolvency, reorganisation, receivership, or assignment for the benefit of creditors, or the application of laws or equitable principles affecting creditors' rights generally, your Personal Information may, subject to applicable law, be treated, transferred, or used by third parties.

11. COMMITMENT

We are committed to protecting your privacy. Protecting your privacy online is an evolving area, and RocketPlay's Services are constantly evolving to meet these demands. We employ commercially reasonable physical, administrative, and electronic security measures and precautions to protect your Personal Information from unauthorised access or use and to ensure the integrity and security of your Personal Information.

If your Personal Information is accessed by an unauthorised third party, we will not be responsible for any direct or indirect damage caused as a result of such unauthorised access. Unfortunately the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your Personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of any data transmitted to or through the Services. You acknowledge and agree that any transmission will be at your own risk.

We recommend that you keep your login and password private and secure. For the avoidance of doubt it is clarified (and you hereby agree) that we cannot and will not be liable for any loss or damage that arises as a result of any failure to protect your password or account information.
